### Program Rules

Students must complete 32 units as follows:

- 24 x core psychology courses (27 units)
- 1 x core statistics course (1 unit)
- 4 x elective courses (4 units)

**Note:** International on-campus students must commence the Bachelor of Psychology (Honours) in Trimester 1. Domestic students may commence the Bachelor of Psychology (Honours) in Trimester 1, 2 or 3, noting that only the Trimester 1 intake supports full time enrolment. Please refer to the recommended enrolment patterns for more information.
